## **OPEN EXHIBITOR BARN RULES**

- 1. Read and sign open exhibitor barn rules.
- 2. Exhibitors are responsible for the care and maintenance of their animal, along with assigned barn duties. Immediate family may help, but it is ultimately the participant's responsibility.
- 3. Exhibitors will not care for or handle animals that are not their own unless they have verbal or written permission.
- 4. Open exhibitors may not feed and water 4H animals unless they are the 4Her who is exhibiting them.
- 5. If there are any concerns about the health or well-being of an animal, the barn superintendent should be notified immediately. If the Superintendent cannot be found, the Open Class Livestock Superintendent from the fair board should be contacted.
- 6. All emergency contact information will be left with the barn superintendent at the time of animal entry.
- 7. Exhibitors are responsible for the overall barn appearance and cleanliness of the open class area.
- 8. Exhibitors are responsible for all necessary animal items. This can include and may not be limited to animal food, feed containers, show and grooming equipment. Please use feed containers that are clean and neat in appearance.
- 9. The Show Ring is not to be used as a location to exercise animals.
- 10. No advertisements or for sale signs may be attached to the cages or stalls. Only those designated by the barn superintendent are allowed.
- 11. Open exhibitors may set up chairs or grooming stations in the barns if they do not block walkways or other exhibits.
